

The last FIP exhibition in Latin America occurred in 1993. After seventeen years, the idea of making a World Stamp Exhibition in Brazil was growing fast and started taking shape in May 2010, at Portugal World Stamp Exhibition. The project for a Brazilian Exhibition was presented during FIP's 71st Congress and received unanimous approval and provisional FIP sponsorship.

In July 2011, during PHILANIPPON at Yokohama/Japan, a reception was offered for the official launching of the exhibition. After a long period of discussions and negotiations with Brazilian Postal Office, the agreement for the sponsorship of FIP was finally signed in 2012 November 17, at Chicago/USA (CHICAGOPEX).

BRASILIANA 2013 (http://brasiliana-2013.blogspot.com.br/) is one of the events promoted by Brazilian Post Office to celebrate the 350th years of Postal Services in Brazil, as well as the 170 years of the issuance of Bull's Eyes emission, the second stamp launched in the world. It will be held at PIER MAUÁ (http://www.piermaua.com.br/pt-br/acesso-e-localizacao.html), in the city of Rio de Janeiro (http://www.rioquiaoficial.com.br/) from November 19 to 25, 2013.

The organizing committee of **BRASILIANA** is composed by members of Brazilian Post Office and philatelists designated by FEBRAF (Brazilian Philatelic Federation). The committee will be chaired by Mr. Wagner Pinheiro (President of Brazilian Post Office), along with Mr. Marcelo Gladio Studart (President of FEBRAF) as Vice-president.
